Motor cover conversion kit for MilchMobil+

1 Introduction

These installation instructions put you in the position to upgrade the conversion kit safely as intended.

- > In addition, follow the instructions in the original operating manual of the MilchMobil.

2.1 Target group

2.1.1 Necessary qualifications of the service technician

Only trained Service technicians are authorised to install the conversion kit.

Service technicians are electricians with appropriate qualifications, i.e. they are able to assess the work assigned to them and detect potential risks on the basis of their technical training as well as their knowledge of the relevant standards. This also includes the knowledge of relevant accident prevention regulations, generally accepted safety regulations, EU guidelines and country-specific standards and provisions.

2.2 Indication of hazards


Dangers are indicated by a key word and a corresponding sign, depending on the severity and probability:

	<p>Caution!</p> <p>For a potentially dangerous situation which may cause minor injuries or material damage.</p>
Attention	For a potentially harmful situation in which the product or a nearby item can be damaged.
Note	For application notes and other useful information.

However, it is just as important to observe any other notes and information which are not highlighted to avoid failures which, in turn, may cause direct or indirect injuries or material damage.

1	Fastening screws 2x
2	Top cover
3	Front cover

4 Installing the conversion kit



1. Make sure the MilchMobil is on a firm and level surface.
2. Make sure that the mains plug has been removed from the mains and that the MilchMobil is switched off.
3. Screw the top cover, using the supplied screws, to the front cover.



1 Top cover


2 Front cover

4. Undo the hexagon screws on the motor cover and remove the cover.



1 Hexagon screws 6x


5. Undo the two hexagon screws on the rear side of the ground drive only slightly so that you will be able to attach the conversion kit more easily.

1 Hexagon screw

6. Slide the conversion kit into the opening of the ground drive. The upper cover must be positioned above the motor at this time.



7. Screw the conversion kit tightly to the MilchMobil. Use the previous hexagon screws.

Note: The longer hexagon screw belongs to the bottom-most bore.

8. Screw the two hexagon screws to the rear side of the ground drive so they are once again tight.
9. Seal the transition along the entire length between the base frame and the tank with a silicon.
